2007 ROAD PROGRAM

After reviewing the list of roads to be paved in the road program, Councilman Ranally asked about paving Second Street. Service Director Tomaselli obtained a cost of \$170,000 for paving and curbs on Second Street from Clark Avenue to Grove Avenue. Mr. Tomaselli said that the curbing from Skiff Street to Grove Avenue on the north side would not have to be done. This would lower the cost of Second Street. Paving Second Street, with curbing, and including the streets on the list presented at the previous meeting would take the road program up to \$1,081,000 plus \$90,000 for engineering. Mr. Tomaselli suggested bidding the road program with Second Street and then determining what will be done after the bids are in. \$1 million has been appropriated. Mr. Rogowski explained that although the city will collect \$1.2 million from the levy, there may be change orders on Mentor Avenue and a 20% share for paving Rt. 91 from the Eastlake line to Euclid Avenue.

Mrs. Manning asked if anyone had an opinion on Kaiser Court if any street had to be dropped. It is a non-residential street. Mayor Anderson stated that Kaiser Court is in bad shape.

Councilman Fiala suggested listing the streets in a priority that goes from the lowest number to the highest as they are shown on the list scoring the street's condition.

Councilman Black asked if the upper part of Second Street between Clark Avenue and Erie St. could be considered either in this project or in the sewer project. Mayor Anderson said that this would take away \$100,000 from something else. Also, there is not enough money in the sewer project. This street would be the next priority to do and could be discussed if there are discussions regarding taking out Kaiser Court.

The Service Committee Meeting adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
