EAS#2-1-08

Proposed project will be a 6,260 sq. ft. single story addition to the existing ± 3,000 sq. ft. single story building (The Van Gorder Building) located on the campus of the Andrews Osborne Academy, 38588 Mentor Ave. Submitted by David P. Harris, Jr., Intern Architect.

Ms. Popp explained that the addition to the existing building will be used for classrooms and offices. A representative from Aztech Engineering explained the storm water detention on the project which will also correct some existing storm water problems.

Chairman Fiala said he noted that this is an addition to the three-story St. John Building, which is an academic addition to an existing academic building and it will be replacing the existing clinic. The addition cannot be seen from Rt. 20 or Kirtland Road.

The Committee recommended approval of EAS#2-1-08.
