Frank DeMaria, age 38, of Willowick, was charged yesterday by the Willoughby Police Department for the theft of construction vehicles and equipment from the Lou Severino Construction Company.

On July 13, 2009 the Lou Severino Company reported a 2003 Chevrolet truck, Caterpillar skidsteer with trailer and other equipment stolen from their business. The truck was discovered abandoned in Cleveland on July 15, 2009. The trailer and equipment were missing.

Detectives received information that DeMaria, a former part-time employee of the construction company, may have been involved with the theft.

Detectives later learned that Demaria sold a stolen concrete saw to a Euclid pawn shop and sold the skidsteer and trailer to a Euclid landscaping company. The property has been recovered with the cooperation of the businesses involved.

DeMaria has been charged with the following crimes:

Two (2) counts of Breaking and Entering, a felony of the fifth degree.

Three (3) counts of Grand Theft, a felony of the fourth degree.

One (1) count of Grand Theft, a felony of the fifth degree.

This case remains under investigation.
